

From September 2017, children aged 3 and 4 may be eligible for 30 hours (15 additional hours to those they currently receive) if they meet the eligibility criteria below:

- Your child will be aged 3 or 4
- Both parents must be working, or the sole parent is working in a lone parent family
- Each parent earns on average, a weekly minimum equivalent to 16 hours at National Minimum Wage or National Living Wage
- Each parent must have an annual income of less than £100,000
- You live in England.

The offer of the additional 15 hours is subject to availability and space in the nursery and will be offered on a first come first served basis, as per our admissions policy, which can be found on our website or is available from the main office.

Highfield Nursery School provides a welcoming setting for families and their children.

We work closely with parents/carers to make sure they are active partners in all areas of the care their child receives and their individual development.

Highfield provides many opportunities for children to feel stimulated and happy in a safe and secure setting.

We encourage learning through play to promote and develop children's individual skills, knowledge and understanding. Linking play with a child's unique knowledge and understanding and real life experiences such as the 'outdoors' and using natural and everyday resources encourages children to feel connected to the world around them, to themselves and with each other.

We provide children with stimulating activities and experiences in line with The Early Years Foundation Stage Framework.

At Highfield Nursery we offer sessions for children aged 2-5years old.

Our sessions are Monday - Friday 8am-4pm as set out below:

9am-12noon

12noon-3pm

We offer a breakfast club (8am-9am), a lunch (12noon-1pm) and an after school sessions (3-4pm) subject to availability, at the following costs:

Breakfast Club: £6.60 (2 year old) £6.40 (3+ year old)

Lunch: £2.60 per day

After School Sessions: £5.80 (2 year old) £5.60 (3+ year old)

We also offer, where available, additional hours at the following cost:

3-hour session: £17.40 (2 year old) £16.80 (3+ year old)

We also ask for £25 per half term to cover costs of consumable items
