Sun Smart Policy – January 2023

At Highfield we want all children and adults to enjoy the sun safely.

We will work with staff, children and parents to achieve this through:

Education – these measures are in place

- We will talk to all children late in the Spring Term and early in the Summer Term about safety in the sun
- We will produce a booklet for parents and children informing them about sun safety
- We will use the notice board in the entrance to promote sun safety and always remind everyone through our summer newsletter about sun safety

Protection – an ongoing process

Clothing:

- We will actively encourage all children to wear a hat when playing outside
- We have hats to lend children when they forget their own
- All adults will wear hats when outside to set a good example

Sunscreen:

- We ask parents and carers and remind children daily to put sun cream on before they come in
- Written permission is sort from parents of children spending the whole day in nursery or at daycare (children provide their own named sun cream)
- Sometimes when it's very hot we may choose not to go out in the midday sun
- Practitioners wear gloves to apply sun cream to children. Clean gloves for each child.
